Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2022023263A1] The present invention relates to a method for treating a plastic pyrolysis oil, comprising: (a) selectively hydrogenating said feedstock to obtain a hydrogenated effluent; (b) hydrotreating said hydrogenated effluent to obtain a hydrotreated effluent; (c) performing a first hydrocracking step on said hydrotreated effluent to obtain a first hydrocracked effluent; (d) separating the hydrocracked effluent in the presence of an aqueous stream, to obtain a gaseous effluent, a liquid aqueous effluent and a liquid hydrocarbon effluent; (e) fractionating the liquid hydrocarbon effluent to obtain at least one gas stream, at least one naphtha cut and a heavier cut; (f) performing a second hydrocracking step on the heavier cut to obtain a second hydrocracked effluent; (g) recycling at least a portion of said second hydrocracked effluent in said separation step (d).
