[origin: WO2022112720A1] The bar-carrying cup (18) of a refill R comprises a lateral wall (29), a sliding slot (14), a housing (39) for receiving the bar B, a stud (40) which is secured to the lateral wall (29) and which has a stem (17), a means (55b) for stopping relative forward displacement in relation to a refill cap (27) which is located towards the front end (31) of the lateral wall (29), where the stem (17) can extend through the slot (14) and is extended by a distal manipulation slider (41), and an arrangement in association with the case which comprises a radially resiliently deformable structure (42).
