Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2022162571A1] In a motorcycle with fairing (1), to facilitate the inflow of air from the front into the fairing (21), a front opening (23) is provided in the front portion of the fairing (21). The front opening (23) has a smaller extension in vertical direction with respect to the fairing itself, so that the upper area of the front portion of fairing is open to allow the direct inflow of an air flow (F) generated by the forward movement of the motorcycle (1). Vice versa, the lower area of the front portion of the fairing (21) is closed by a covering (31) which forms an aerodynamic profile with a front outer surface (31a) and a rear inner surface (31b), which divides a descending flow of air into an outer partial flow (FA) and an inner partial flow (FB).
