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

shaped main frame (5) which has on its entire circumference a circular face (3) that is parallel to a golf club and player's arms and is gradually inclined from outside to the center. The main frame further has a center (4) opening at its center and the upper half of the main frame is bent forward. The main frame is set up in a backwardly inclined state and on the front surface of the circular face are shown three loci (15d, 16d, 17d) indicating the clubhead arcs of backswing, downswing and follow-through and a plurality of straight lines (18) indicating clubshaft arc. When a player swings his golf club along the circular face, the abovementioned loci move laterally according to the player's weight shift producing substantially an elliptic swing arc.
