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(54) Printing form stretching device in a printer.

(57) A printing form stretching device in a printer secures the form stretching in the direction of the printing line and next to this one. The device comprises cone-shaped pressure rollers (12, 13) of resilient material with high friction coefficient which press the printing form (8) next to the edges against a platen (8).

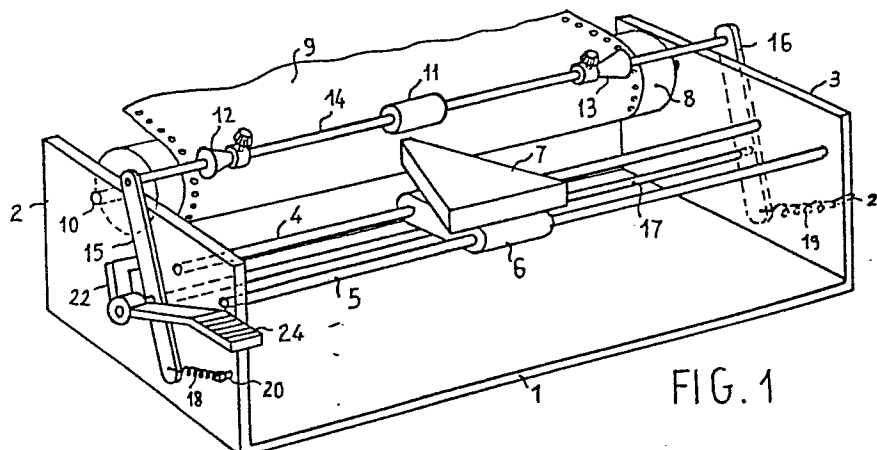
