

[54] Improvements in or relating to amusement apparatuses.

(57) A game playing apparatus has a reader (20) for reading the code on a code carrier such as a key (40). This code is compared by a microprocessor (36) with an internally stored or programmed winning code and, if the codes correspond, an indication is provided that a prize has been won. Insertion of the key also causes a raffle voucher to be issued by a printer (21), and the apparatus selects, randomly or pseudo- FIG.5. randomly, one of the raffle tickets issued during a raffle cycle. The winning number is displayed on a display (4) and a predetermined period indicated on a display (5) during which the key associated with the winning voucher must be re-inserted into the reader (20) in order to claim a prize, for which a voucher is then printed by the printer (21).
