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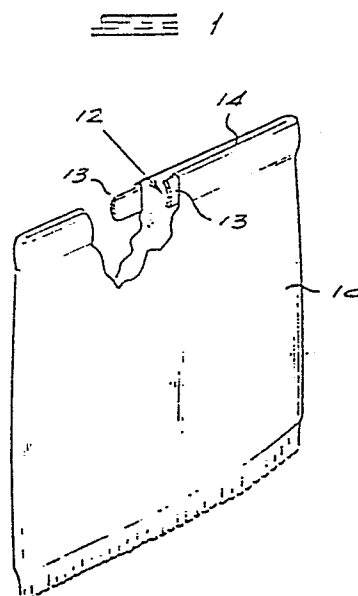
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54 **Package opening means.**

57 This invention relates to a package which finds particular application as a sealed small paper package or sachet for sugar or the like. The package includes opening means constituted by one or more flexible opener strips 13 which are deformable to rupture the package or a mouth of the package.
