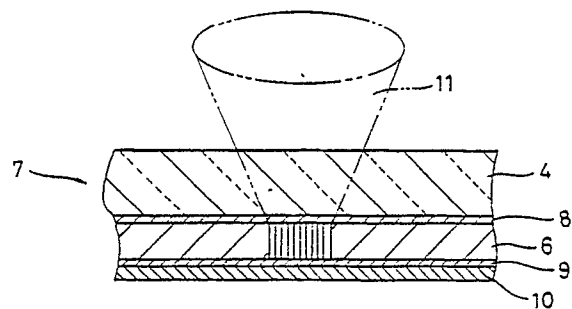

57 A magneto-optic memory medium of an amorphous alloy having uniaxial magnetic anisotropy and prepared by incorporating 2 to 15 atom mol % of yttrium Y into an alloy represented by the formula $(\text{Gd}_\alpha \text{Tb}_{1-\alpha})_{1-\beta} \text{A}_\beta$ wherein A is a transition metal, and α and β satisfy the requirements of $0.5 \leq \alpha \leq 0.7$ and $0.6 < \beta \leq 0.8$.
