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Games racket with vibration-damping assembly.

A games racket includes one or more vibration-damping assemblies (20) in its throat portion. Each assembly (20) may comprise a metal rod (21) supported at either end by elastically-deformable mounting-members (30, 31). The dimensions of the mounting-members (30, 31) relative to the rod (21) are such as to permit the rod (21) to move in the direction of an applied vibration (AA).

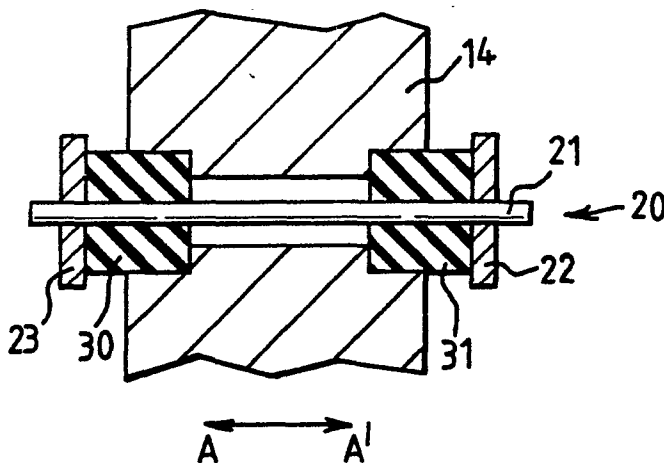
