

- 54 Kit for labelling of clothes.
- The invention relates to a kit for labelling of clothes. According to the invention, kit includes a base label (1) and a support (2) placed over said base label (1), the support (2) having holes (5), placed on its angles, and protrusions (4) positioned on its back face, said protrusions (4) can be inserted

in the corresponding holes (3) of the base label (1). Aforesaid holes (5) of the support (2) permit to fix, by means of screws, a label (7) over aforesaid support (2) in order to permit the use of every number of label (7) and to replace them quickly.
