

The Search Division considers that the present European patent application does not comply with the requirement of unity of invention and relates to several inventions or groups of inventions, namely:

- 1. Claims 1,2-6
- : Table tennis bat with multilayer blade.
- 2. Claims 1,7-16
- : Table tennis bat blade with edge heavier and stiffer than central part.
- 3. Claims 1,17-22
- : Table tennis bat with relatively low frame stiffness in the blade plane and relatively high stiffness in the plane perpendicular to the blade plane.
- 4. Claims 1,23-31
- : Vibration amplifying and transmitting elements.
