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
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(54) Heat-insulating container

(57) A heat-insulating food container includes an injection-molded container body (3) having a bottom wall (3b), a circumferential wall (3a) integrally connected to a periphery of the bottom wall (3b) and upwardly extending therefrom for defining an inner space and an upper open end, and vertical ribs (7) vertically extending along the circumferential wall (3a). The circumferential wall

(3a) includes circumferential wall parts (9a, 9b, 9c) respectively having different diameters and arranged in such a manner as to form the circumferential wall (3a) with the diameter thereof decreasing in a stepwise manner as it advances downwardly, thereby forming corresponding stepped portions on an exterior surface and an interior surface thereof.

1. Claims: 1-3

Subject I (claims 1-3) relates to a cylindrical container having a circumferential wall with parts having different diameters decreasing in a stepped manner as it advances downwardly.

2. Claim: 4

Subject II (claim 4) relates to a container having a downwardly-facing rib forming a double layered annular portion.

3. Claims: 5-8

Subject III (claims 5-8) relates to a container having, an annular stepped portion located near the upper open end of the container and serving as an indicator, and another stepped portion performing a reinforcing function.

4. Claims: 9-10

Subject IV (claims 9 and 10) relates to a container with a particular dimension relation between the thickness of the circumferential wall and the base part of ribs extending along the container.
