(57)A supporting device for longitudinal members of shelving systems, galleries and the like, comprising a bracket unit (11, 111, 211) that is rigidly coupled, by way of engagement elements (15, 115, 215), to a face (16) of an upright (14, 114, 214) that is directed toward the outside of a shelf system, gallery or the like, the bracket

unit (11, 111, 211) being shaped so as to accommodate by resting contact, and lock by way of retention elements (12), a longitudinal member (13, 113, 213) that is supported by at least one additional bracket unit (11, 111, 211), which is rigidly coupled to a corresponding additional upright (13, 113, 213).


