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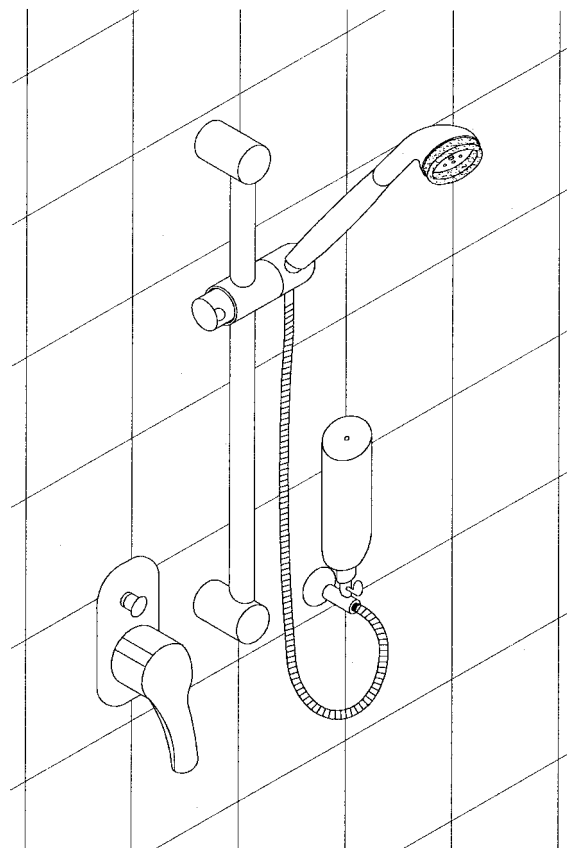
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(54) **Apparatus for mixing products in shower water**

(57) With the diffuser "Slot-Shower" for bubble bath or fluid soaps. The actual hydraulic system of the showers become excellent and faultless because this system replies all sanitary requirements for personal hygiene , specially to cancel all problems to soap oneself the back and legs under the knees , the hydraulic complex "Slot-Shower" is applaied between the flexible hosepipe and the main central house waterpipe, in particular the water flow is controlled like one's necessities to have a sense of wellbeing wished.
