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## (54) Fluid cylinder, preferably for actuating a grab bucket

(57) An actuator device (8), in particular for an orange-peel bucket (1), having a support (9), a hydraulic jack (10) provided with a liner (15) and a rod (18) movable along an actuating axis (19), and a joint (24) hinging in the jack (10) to the support (9); the joint (24) is provided with inner passages to feed oil to the jack (10) without outer flexible pipes.


