

(54) Adjustable shoe assembly for a reciprocating saw

(57) A reciprocating saw (10) includes a locking mechanism for a shoe (14) of the reciprocating saw. The mechanism includes a lever (22) mounted on the saw body movable to a first position where the saw blade (12) is clamped in place. It also includes a lock pin with a body, a reduced circumference section, and a pin shoulder ad-

jacent the reduced circumference section. The pin has a locked position where the pin shoulder abuts the shoe shoulder whereby the pin locks the shoe in place and an unlocked position where the shoe shoulder may translate through the clearance defined by the reduced circumference section. The lever urges the pin toward the locked position when the lever is in the first position.
