

(54) PVC window or door frame with an aesthetically improved outer surface

(57) A PVC window or door frame with an aesthetically improved outer surface, comprises frame polyvinylchloride extruded section members (1), including on at least an exposed to view surface portion thereof a natural wood veneering coating (2) protected by fire retard-

ant paints designed for providing the section member with a high resistance against section member welding temperatures.

A method for making a PVC window or door frame with a layer of natural wood material vaneering.

Dependent claim 12 is not clear and concise. The subject-matter of the claim is defined by reference to the description, the drawings and the claims, whereas Article 84 EPC specifies that the claims as such shall define the subject-matter for which protection is sought. Furthermore the scope of the claimed invention is rendered indefinite by the reference to the description and the drawings (EPC Guidelines, C-III, 4.17). Reference is also made to Rule 43 (6) EPC which specifies that claims shall not, except where absolutely necessary, refer to the description and the drawings. The subject-matter for which protection is sought should be defined in terms of the technical features of the invention (43 (6) EPC). Since it is unclear which features of the application are intended to be included into claim 12, a search of this claim is not possible.
