(57) Furniture with built-in table, of the type including a folding table, wherein the folded table on its top board,

is fully incorporated into the furniture, and it has lower wheels at the end of the table legs.

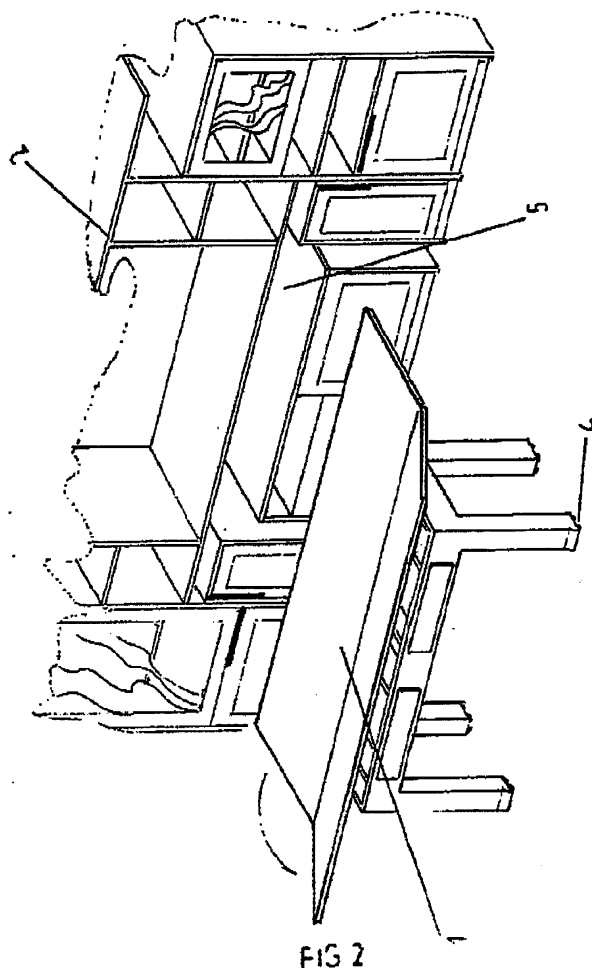

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Description

Object of the invention

[0001] The present invention, as its title indicates, relates to furniture with built-in table. It is a particular and innovative creation. It is meant to solve the space problems arising when people try to put together a large group of people at home, for instance, when there is a celebration. This invention will let you an extra free room that can be used for many other purposes other than a celebration.

Background of the invention

[0002] Nowadays, furnishings for living rooms, (that can be more or less large in order to make people's live a little more comfortable) are well known. In general, due to the small size of houses, people tend to incorporate useful folding articles in order to make the most of limited spaces. At the present time, the petitioner is not aware of the existence of furniture with built-in table like the one hereby describe. We want to make now a description of our product, which is particularly addressed to solve the possible disadvantages of the current existing furniture, as discussed above.

Description of the invention

[0003] The present invention, referred to a furniture with built-in table includes the following: a folded table on its top board which is fully incorporated into the furniture, in such a way that, with lower wheels on the legs, and simply pulling the board out, you get the board removed out of the furniture. Once you open it by splitting the top board, it is ready to use.

Drawings of the invention

[0004] In order to complement the description and to facilitate a better comprehension of the characteristics of the invention, we attach as an integral part of the description, a set of drawings. These drawings have an illustrative and not limitative character, and they represent the following:

Figure 1 shows a frontal view of the furniture with built-in table.

Figure 2 shows in detail the table in position out of the furniture.

Preferred embodiment of the invention

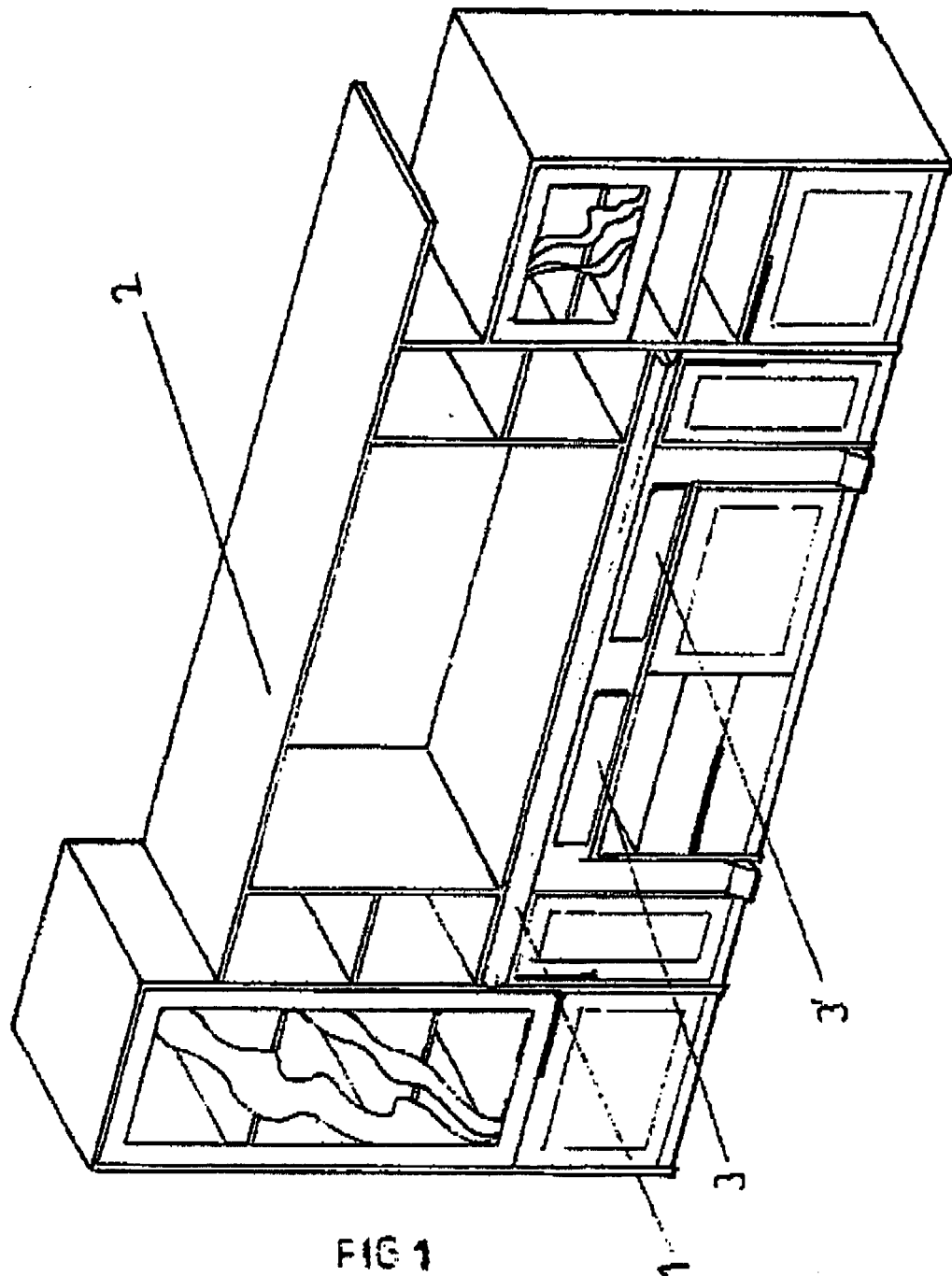
[0005] When the consumer needs to use the table (1) incorporated into the furniture (2), he simply has to stand in front of the set in an upright position, open the drawers (3) and (3') pull slightly towards him, so that the table slides on its wheels (4, and gets completely out of the

space (5) in which it was built. Thus the table (1) with the folded board splits into the top and gets opened and ready to be used as a coffee table and / or dining table, proceeding to perform the same operation the way around to leave the table (1) properly placed and incorporated into the furniture (2).

Claims

1. Furniture with built-in table, of the type including a folding table, **characterized by** the fact that the folded table on its top board, is fully incorporated into the furniture, and it has lower wheels at the end of the table legs.



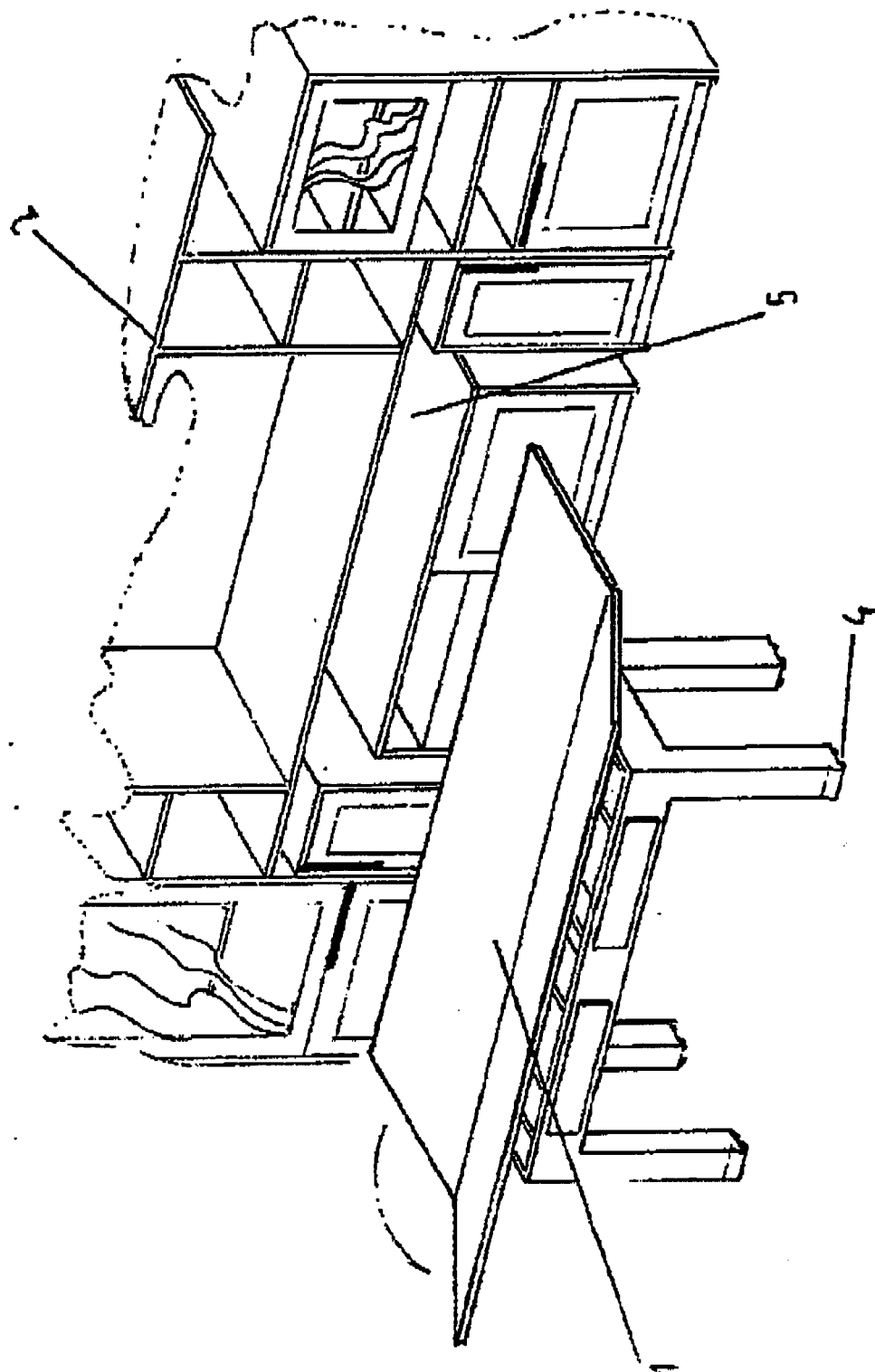
