#### (54)Monitoring casino table game events

(57)An electronic system is provided for recording data associated with gaming events in casino table games. Via an interface (16) data is received from a sorter (37) assigned to a roulette table (30) for sorting casino currency and for providing data associated with a value of the sorted casino currency. Via an interface (13) data is received from a reader (21) assigned to a game table (20) other than roulette for reading electronic tags embodied in the casino currency the reader (21) covering a designated area of the game table (20),


