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(54) **METHOD FOR MAKING A CONCEALED VENT FOR VENTILATION, HEATING OR
CONDITIONING SYSTEMS, AND VENT ASSEMBLY FOR CARRYING OUT SUCH METHOD**

(57) The method according to the invention, for making a concealed vent for ventilation, heating or air conditioning systems, comprises the following operations: A) providing a ventilation conduit (15) for introducing or drawing air in an environment (A) to be ventilated, heated or cooled; the ventilation conduit (15) is concealed in a wall (P) which delimits the environment (A) and opens outside of it through a wall opening (7); B) providing a diffusor panel (9) located in front of the wall opening (7) so as to conceal it allowing the air coming from the ventilation conduit (15) to come out from the opening (7) and be introduced in the environment (A); the perimeter of the diffusor panel (9) ideally contains the outer parameter of the wall opening (7), and at least the perimeter edges of the diffusor panel (9) project from the surface of the wall (P) which delimits the environment (A) for a maximum distance (D) comprised between 0.1 centimetres and ten centimetres.

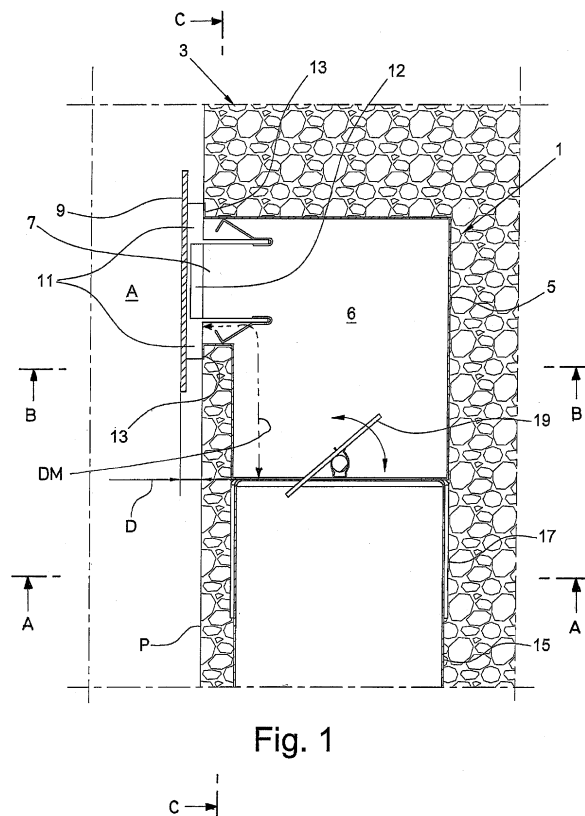

Claims 1-7 relate to a method for making a concealed vent for ventilation, heating or air conditioning systems, comprising the steps of:

-providing a ventilation conduit for introducing or drawing air in an environment to be ventilated, heated or cooled, where the ventilation conduit is concealed inside a wall which delimits the environment and exits outside the same through a wall opening;

-providing a diffuser panel located in front of the wall opening so as to conceal it allowing the air coming from the ventilation conduit to exit from the wall opening and be introduced in the environment, where the perimeter of the diffuser panel ideally contains the outer parameter of the wall opening, and at least the perimeter edges of the diffuser panel project from the surface of the wall which delimits the environment by a maximum distance comprised between 0,1 centimetres and ten centimetres (inventive concept).

II. Claims 8-14 relate to a vent assembly for obtaining the method according to claim 1, wherein the vent assembly comprises an air casing in turn comprising: a box-shaped body in which the wall opening is obtained; a diffuser panel; and one or more fixing brackets or spacers arranged for fixing the diffuser panel to the box-shaped body maintaining it in front of the wall opening and at a maximum distance from the edges of such opening comprised between 0.1-1.2 centimetres (inventive concept).
